Materials

- Worsted weight yarn in dark brown, light brown, white, and black
- Size H (5mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Abbreviations

- ch = chain

- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- inc = increase
- dec = decrease

Pattern

Round 1: ch 4, sl st to form a ring. (4)

Round 2: ch 1, (sc, ch 1) 12 times. (12)

Round 3: ch 1, *sc in next sc, hdc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next sc, hdc in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * around. (12)

Round 4: ch 1, *sc in next sc, hdc in next hdc, dc in next dc, hdc in next hdc, sc in next sc; repeat from * around. (12)

Round 5: ch 1, *sc in next sc, hdc in next hdc, dc in next dc, hdc in next hdc, dec over next 2 sc; repeat from * around. (10)

Round 6: ch 1, *sc in next sc, hdc in next hdc, dc in next dc, hdc in next hdc, sc in next sc; repeat from * around. (10)

Round 7: ch 1, *hdc in next hdc, dc in next dc, hdc in next hdc, sc in next sc; repeat from * around. (10)

Round 8: ch 1, *hdc in next hdc, dc in next dc, hdc in next hdc, dec over next 2 sc; repeat from * around. (8)

Round 9: ch 1, *hdc in next hdc, dc in next dc, hdc in next hdc, sc in next sc; repeat from * around. (8)

Round 10: ch 1, *hdc in next hdc, dc in next dc, dec over next 2 hdc; repeat from * around. (6)

Round 11: ch 1, *hdc in next hdc, dc in next dc; repeat from * around. (6)

Round 12: ch 1, *hdc in next hdc, dec over next 2 hdc; repeat from * around. (4)

Round 13: ch 1, *hdc in next hdc; repeat from * around. (4)

Fasten off and weave in loose ends.

Assembly

To assemble the horse applique, simply sew the pieces together using a yarn needle and matching thread. Start by sewing the head to the body, then sew the ears to the head. Next, sew the legs to the body, and finally, sew the tail to the back of the horse.

Variations

This versatile pattern can be customized to create a variety of different looks. For example, you can use different colors of yarn to create a horse of any color you like. You can also add embellishments such as beads or sequins to give your horse a little extra personality.

Tips

For a more realistic look, use variegated yarn for the horse's body. This will give the horse a natural-looking coat.

To make the horse stand up on its own, use a small amount of stuffing to fill the body. You can also add a wire armature to the legs to help them stand up.
