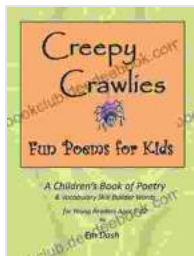

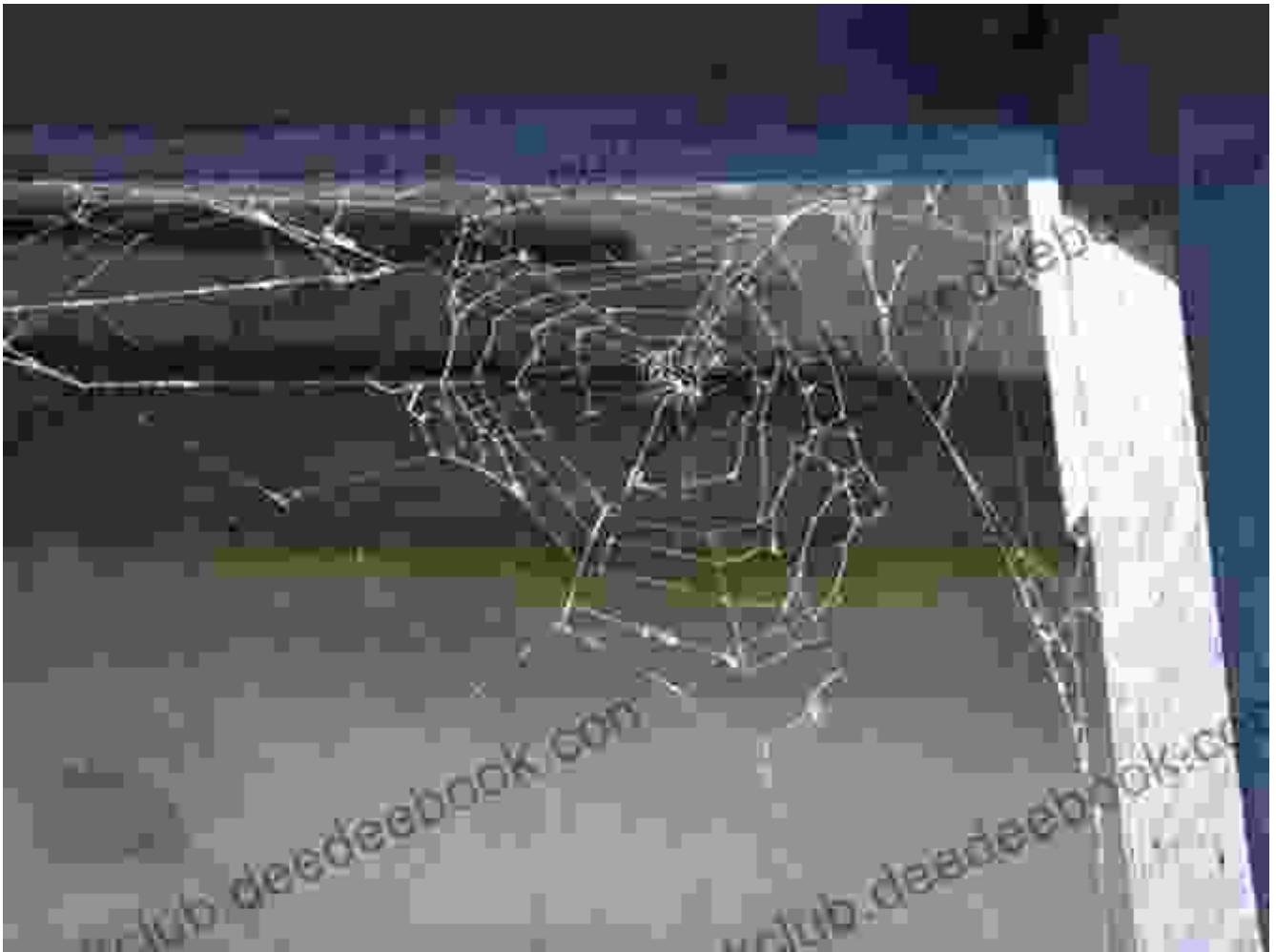

A breathtaking sight, a pure delight.

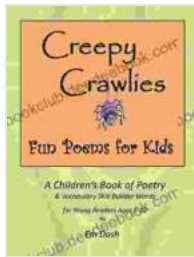


Oh, the wonders of creepy crawlies,

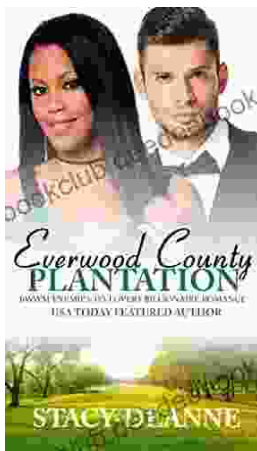
