Choosing Yarn and Needles

Basic Knitting Techniques

Casting On

Casting on is the first step in any knitting project. It involves creating a row of stitches on your needles that will form the foundation of your knitting.

1. Make a slip knot and place it on the left-hand needle.
2. Insert the right-hand needle into the slip knot from back to front.
3. Hook the yarn onto the right-hand needle.

Knit Stitch

Purl Stitch

The purl stitch is the other basic knitting stitch. It creates a fabric with a textured, rib-like appearance.

3. Hook the yarn onto the right-hand needle.

6. Slide the old loop off the left-hand needle.

Intermediate Knitting Techniques

Increases

Increases are used to add stitches to your knitting. This can be done in a variety of ways, including:

- Knitting into the front and back of a stitch
- Making a yarn over
- Using a double knit stitch

Decreases

Decreases are used to reduce the number of stitches in your knitting. This can be done in a variety of ways, including:

- Knitting two stitches together

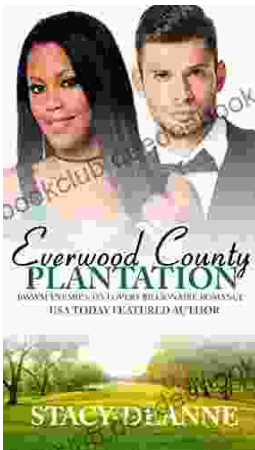
