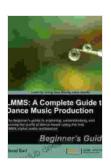

- 5. **Arrange your song.** Click on the Play button in the Song Editor to start playing your song. As the song plays, you can use the Song

- Editor to arrange the tracks. You can move the tracks around, add effects, and change the volume and panning of the tracks.
- 6. **Mix your song.** Once you have arranged your song, you can mix it down. To do this, click on the File menu and select Export. In the Export dialog box, select the WAV format and choose a location to save the file. Click on the OK button to export your song.

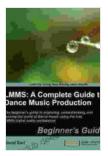
Tips for Creating Dance Music in LMMS

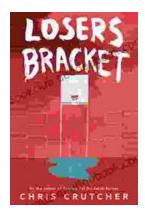
