



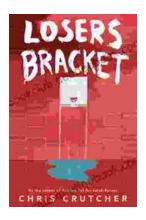
Durrell was also a passionate conservationist, and he founded the Durrell Wildlife Conservation Trust, which has helped to save endangered species around the world.

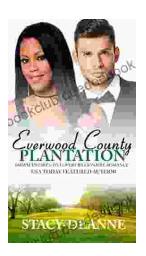
